Right training means less maintenance expenses and longer machine lifespan. The course instructs participants in operating and inspection procedures focused on all aspects of operation, like for instance right slinging and rigging. Lifting practices would be demonstrated together with recommended procedures for review by your safety committee. Sessions would feature demonstration videos.
