Operators of heavy equipment are highly trained workers who can troubleshoot, repair and diagnose heavy machines in a work shop or on site. Mechanics need to be available to transport their tools to a job site and perform repair and maintenance in a variety of settings.

It could be possible for delivery drivers to acquire work with just a CDL, even if for various jobs, specific endorsements might be required. For instance, delivering large pieces of machines or parts that are exceptionally big for construction projects will need the driver to finish further training to handle and haul huge loads. Normally, the drivers operate with chaperone vehicles that are driven by drivers who are trained. These chaperone vehicles usually escort the delivery truck to its destination.
