MSDS or also known as Material Safety Data Sheet training is also included in the course. Though not directly related to the use of a forklift, MSDS training is vital if an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on people and right methods of handling spills.
