Order Picker Training Chandler - The order picker lift truck allows for those working in a warehouse setting to lift pallets utilizing forks. This electronically-powered equipment is also referred to as a stock picker and is like a lift truck, enabling a person to access high up places on a platform. Order pickers are commonly found within warehouse settings and are useful for specialized purposes.

Located close to the floor is the operator platform, that is where the operator can direct the machine forward, backward or from side to side, and lifts the forks to perform appropriate level tasks. To be able to get into materials on a high shelf, the platform is raised. The unit has a counterweight on the other end in order to provide balance.

Once the materials have been picked, the individual is lowered on the platform and the unit is driven to the next site. Several companies have policies against moving the order picker while the platform is elevated. Although the unit can be used to place pallets on a shelf, stackers and forklifts are more frequently used for to stack pallets.

As the unit is powered electrically, the battery has to be recharged quite frequently. This is a factor in warehouses and factories which run multiple shifts. Extra batteries can be bought if the unit is in use during back-to-back shifts.

It is really important to check the capacity of the battery, prior to choosing an order picker. The various models will have load restrictions and limitations in their reach abilities. Different order picker models have different travel and lift speeds. The fork size likewise differs. Nearly all order pickers have a fork size of about 1.5 m. While higher lift and travel speeds could help increase production, they could also cause more accidents. Operators utilizing order pickers should be well trained on the particular units they would be operating.
